- Jayleen Kokis, Jennifer Hainrick, and Julia Martin participated in a Web Institute for their Masters in Library Science program at University of North Texas that was held at the Outrigger Guam Resort in Guam on Aug. 9-19, 2011.
- Bruce attended the PARBICA 14 conference held in Apia, Samoa on August 20-29
- LRC staff (Jenny, Juvel, Karleen, Lucy from National campus, Kersweet from Chuuk campus, Nercy from Pohnpei campus, and Susan from Yap campus) participated in the President' Retreat on Aug. 24-26, 2011.

ACTIVITY HIGHLIGHTS

Chuuk Campus

• LRC staff continues to assist students, faculty and staff with information and other library related work. Media staff assisted setting up PA system during the registration week and assisted Mr. Higashi's class to show some DVDs for his World History class while he was in Pohnpei for the President's retreat.

FMI Campus

• Ms. Pagal participated in a workshop from August 8th-12th hosted by the YSLA (Yap State Library Association) which focused on how to improve the libraries at all the schools on the island and outer islands of Yap, and familiarizing the teachers, who are part time librarians, on how a library works; Dewey classification was introduced to the local teachers; Visits were made to six public school libraries: Tomil, FMI, Gagil, Gilman, Dalipebinaw, and Bael; Books were also donated from Yap Campus during the last day of the workshop

Kosrae Campus

- It took two days and six librarians to offload a 40 ft. container packed with donated furniture from REPAC
- Director Kephas provided a 2.5 ton cargo truck to aid in transporting donated furniture to 6 school libraries

National Campus

- Lucy: Involved in the re-arrangement of the Processing Room for a conducive place to work with; Assisted former Acting Director (Juvelina) in weeding out the outdated and duplicate materials stored inside the supply room
- MITC: A smart board has been installed in MITC Room 1 and now awaiting for testing; The big writing board mounted in MITC Room 1 has been constructed into a portable board; A new outlet was put in MITC recording room for LRC/MITC laminator machine; MITC received a new Mac laptop for editing; MITC submitted a request to Micronesian Seminar for their first productions in DVD format for COM instructional use and was granted provided that MITC replaced the blank DVDS for requested videos; Karleen is now working on another batch of books (about 110 titles) to upload onto the Pacific Digital Library site
- **Juvel**: Compiled the July 2011 monthly report of the LRC-National and state campuses and submitted to Acting VPIA; Assessed and cleared donated materials and gave away duplicate copies to other schools; Re-arranged tables and chairs to provide more space; Organized the Circulation and CRC Collection; Conducted a meeting on Aug. 11th with the LRC staff in preparation for the first day of instruction; Prepared bibliography for the month of August 2011; Attended a meeting for Planning and Resources Committee meeting on August 11th; Conducted a meeting on Aug. 25th with Susan Guarin (Yap), Nercy Simina (Pohnpei), Kersweet Eria (Chuuk), Jenny Hainrick (National), & Karleen Manuel (National) to address their concerns/problems encountered in their respective areas
