The phrase 'health indicators' should be removed, this phrase is no longer used in academic program reviews, according to consultants. A seat cost formula needs to be developed and added to the policy. In section P, the term *rival* should be replaced with *regional*. There was discussion on how the data should be displayed on the IRPO website in order to make access easier for faculty and Program Coordinators.
