Discussion on Agenda / Major Topics of Discussion

- I. Call to Order: By Alton Higashi.
- II. Attendance: Above.
- V. <u>Instruction News</u>: Alton spoke on behalf of IC Coordinator. He presented a schedule of important events for all to remember: March 8 (F) = faculty submission of mid-term deficiency notices; March 22 (F) = last day to withdraw with "W"; March 25 (M, 6:30 pm) = potluck dinner with UoG faculty and students; March 27 (W) = classes to be held; Mar 28-29 (ThF) = Easter vacation; April 1 (M) = Founding Day (Anderson Field); April 2 (T) = Cultural Day (Anderson Field); April 3 (W) = no classes; and April 8-12 = early registration for continuing students during Fall 2013.
 - A. <u>Mid-Term Deficiencies</u>, <u>Withdrawals</u>, <u>and Incompletes</u>: Discussion focused on consequences of these academic issues. Their impact on transcripts and financial aid was underscored, in order to impress students on the importance of setting high priority on academic requirements and of maintaining good academic standing.
 - B. <u>Potluck Dinner with UoG</u>: Alton explained that a number of University of Guam faculty and students will be visiting Chuuk Campus. They have requested a potluck dinner on March 25 (M) night.
 - 1. Alton requested that faculty prepare potluck items. More specifications will be forthcoming.
