Discussion of Agenda/Information Sharing:

Cooperative Research and Extension (CRE) managed this meeting with CRE Coordinator Mike Abbe as the facilitator and with a prayer led by Dr. Danilo Mamangon.

The Head of the following offices were called to present their activities, concerns and /or reminders:

1. Dean Kind Kanto

• He observed that many students were not in the Campus due to the Election Day. He will push for Chuuk campus to have a day off during election because the election here covers both national and state unlike other states dealing with only one state election.

- He announced the members of the COM-FSM Board of Regents (BOR) Churchill Edward (pohnpei) as Chairman, Tulensru Waguk (Kosrae), Vice Chairman, Jesse Salalu (Yap), Secretary-Treasurer, Kasio Mida (National Government), member, and Graceful Enlet (Chuuk), member.
- The next BOR meeting will be held at Chuuk at the first week of May that coincides with the last days of the spring semester.
- Staff and Faculty Development Day will be on March 13 in which there will be separate and joint sessions for the staff and faculty. At 12Noon- 1PM, the Chinese Ambassador H.E.Li Jie will be speaking about available scholarship for FSM students from the People's Republic of China. Dean Kanto requested the campus constituents to inform those graduates of COM-FSM to come and listen for this opportunity. He mentioned Lucy Irons, our former student, who is on a Chinese scholarship and almost finished with her studies in China. Furthermore, he called for everyone to think about what are the needs of our campus for this meeting with the Chinese

Ambassador.

- On March 18, the second POW Wow. Students are encouraged to meet with the advisor for advising. This includes how they are doing in their classes, and the remaining courses they need to graduate.
- On March 25, Japanese Ambassador Masaki Saki will visit at 12Noon-1PM to meet the campus community. He will also discuss how his government can assist Chuuk Campus.
- He mentioned that two events will happen at the end of March-Cultural Day (Holiday) and COM founding day. He is enjoining the SBA to layout their plans and activities for these events.
- Lastly, he announced that the College Nurse Marcelly Mariano finished two week training in Mental Health last February.

2. Instruction- Mariano Marcus

4. CRE-Mike Abbe

- A team composed of Dr. Lolita Ragus, Health and Nutrition Agent Hattie Reisom and EFNEP Agent Merly Nelon promoted breadfruit through:
