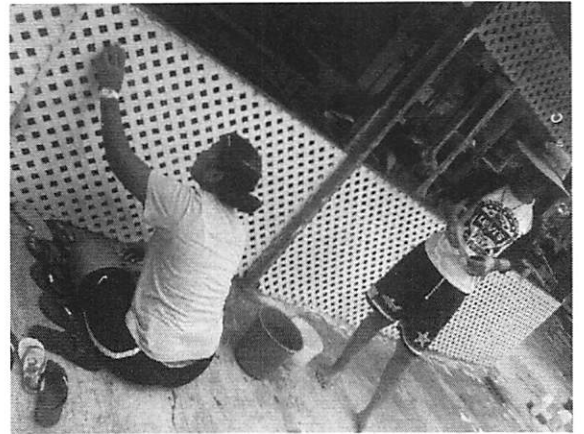
PROJECT 1 AT BAHNASANG
