




Chuu-Chok Track n' Field Assessment


A total number of members that participated in the activity were only 28 and all 28 of them were able to fill out the surveys.




The first question asked students how the atmosphere of the activity was like.




The second question asked about how the activity relates to their experience here at the college.




The third question asked students if the activity showed friendship and warmth. (This was one of our intended outcome.)
