The parents should not spent most of their times gambling bingo and playing cards but to help their kids. He or she suggested that they (parents) should stop these things so that their kids or Nukap will see that they've change.

- ✓ 4th person: Very interesting! Thank you very much!
- ✓ 5th person: He or she really like this program because you Nukap students showed us parents that you guys really cares for our community and at the same time your education. Your program you guys to learn how to speak in a respective ways to your people and that it the only thing that you have to learn.
- ✓ 6th person: He or she really liked all the presentations and the YSO dancers, too! Lastly, he or she suggested that Nukap students that used to drinking alcohol should stop it otherwise it will make you drop-out of school. Wait until you finish your education and have a job then you are free to drink whatever you want to drink. If you stop, then you guys are going to be role models that your brothers and sisters that are growing up will look up to and will also be obedience like you if you change now.
- ✓ 7th person: He or she really liked this program and wanted these kinds of program to be continuing occurring in the community.
- ✓ 8th person: We the parents now understood our roles as parents and thank you Nukap students for letting us know our roles.
- ✓ 9th person: You Nukap Board should also hold a gathering to your members and give them words of advice so that they will understand their roles as students also.
- ✓ 10th person: Congratulation Nukap Students!!! Good Jobs!
- ✓ 11th person: He or she is very glad or happy and hoping that they'll become honorable heroes in the future.

4. There 3 are people who circled the number 1 and 10 with comments.

- ❖ 1st person: He or she circle the number 1 for the number 2 and 10 and all the rest are 10.
 - He or she is sorry for the #1s he or she have circle, he did it because he or she knew that some of the Nukap students have bad behaviors. His or her head is spinning if the Nukap will keep what they've said in their speech or not and he or she hope that they should keep what they delivered.
