January 11, 2014

The strategic used for assessment is survey questionnaires. 72% out of the participants which is 63 counts out of 88 participants in the Welcoming Party took and returned the survey forms. After being tallied, these are the following results.

Out of the 72%:

- > 54% of the students strongly agree that the Welcoming Party was well organized and the set up was great.
- > 63% of the students strongly agreed that the food were enough for everyone.
- > 44% of the students strongly agree that the entertainment was great.
- > 56% of the students strongly agree that they had great time interacting with other residential hall students.
- > 49% of the students strongly agree that the activity promoted socialization and civic mindedness among students.
- Regarding overall level of satisfaction, 44% of the students marked "satisfactory" which is recorded the highest percentage of all the particular choices.
