The students were asked to rate 10 different aspects of the event and to answer with SA for Strongly Agreeing, A for Agreeing, N for Neutral, D for Disagree, SD for Strongly Disagree and NO for No Opinion and those results are as follows:

- 1. The YES!-sponsored farewell banquet was well organized and the set up was great. SA-17, A-2
- 2. Rate the food (Quality and Quantity) and if was good (sufficient) SA 17, A 2
- 3. Entertainment was good SA- 14, A-4, NO-1
- 4. The event promoted interaction among students: SA- 16, A-2, N-1
- Socialization and civic mindedness was promoted to students by YES! officers: SA-17, A-2
- 6. Student would participate in another YES!-sponsored event: SA-18, A-1
- 7. Did the student feel that YES! has been successful in promoting Business Administration at COM-FSM? SA-19
- 8. Student felt safe at the event: SA-18, A-1
- 9. Transportation was efficient and convenient: SA-16, A-2, NO-1

10. Event was considered outstanding and was enjoyed by the student: SA-17, A-2

The overall level of satisfaction for this event was scored as: SA – 16, A-3

Some miscellaneous comments made by the students were:

- 1 expressed that it was a fun activity
- 1 felt that some didn't get to the venue on time due to transportation problems.
- 2 commented on a job well done and for the officers to keep up the good work.
- 1 student felt that there should have been more students to participate and that he himself would be sure to approach other Business Administration students and encourage them to participate more in the YES! activities.
