Scope of Activity

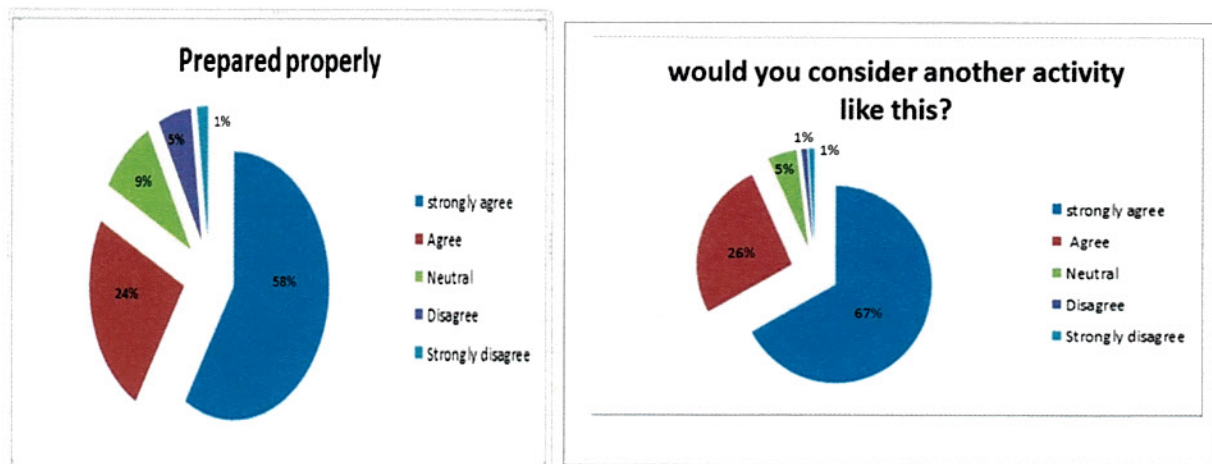

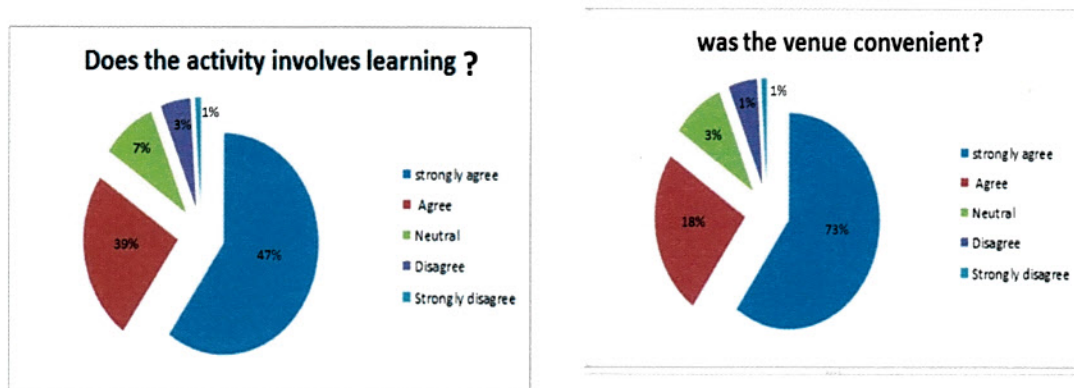
Survey Feedbacks
