



Chuu-Chok VALENTINE's CONCERT Assessment


There was a total of 50 members. As you can see, the number of participants are mostly male, which is good. We do our best to have students participate in our activities to avoid having them engage in other distractions.







We've also asked for students' feedback on the event by having them fill out surveys. The results are followed below:








