


In this activity, there was a great number of continuing students that participated or attended. In addition to that, the total numbers of males were higher that of female.



The following graphs shows the result of the survey questions that were asked to each attendees of the activity.


(INTENDED OUTCOME #1)

Out of 51 students that attended the party, 46 answered this question as SATISFIED, and 5 students responded with NEED IMPROVEMENT.




(INTENDED OUTCOME #2)

Again, out of 51, 48 students answered with SATISFIED while 3 of them responded NEED IMPROVEMENT base on the following question we asked them.




(INTENDED OUTCOME #3)

In this graph, out of 51 students responded SATISFIED, while the number of those who responded to NEED IMPROVEMENTS decreased to only 2 students.




(INTENDED OUTCOME #4)
