This report outlines activities for campus libraries at the College of Micronesia-FSM during the month of May 2016.

PERSONNEL:

- Director Helieisar signed off on Edson Asito's reclassification papers from Media Technician to Information Technology/Media Technician II with the support of Chuuk Campus Dean and IT Director. Papers were returned to HR office for further processing.
- Chuuk campus library assistant Ms. Divine Lokopwe Stephen was on leave from May 18-June 3, 2016 to participate in the FestPac festivities held in Guam. She is scheduled to report back to work on June 6, 2016.
- Karleen Samuel has been accepted into the masters in library science program at the University of North Texas as part of the LEAP II Cohort, with a special focus on digital content management, creation, curation and preservation. She traveled to Honolulu, Hawaii from May 9-26 to participate in the program's Web Institute at the Brigham Young University. She is currently taking three courses this summer 2016. These classes are ED 210-Intro. to Prof. Teaching at COM-FSM, IL 306-Librarian as teacher at University of Maine Augusta and INFO 5000 Information and Knowledge Professions at University of North Texas.
- Jennifer Helieisar traveled to Manila, Philippines from May 28-June 3 to participate at the International Federation of Library Associations and Institutions (IFLA) Building Strong Library Associations (BSLA) Global Meeting to discuss impacts of BSLA on library associations since its inception in 2009. Travel expenses were covered by IFLA.

- Chuuk campus LRC staff completed this year's inventory and submitted the results to LRC Director. LRC Inventory Spring 2016 was done on May 26, 2016. Result are as follows: Total copies=12,209; Copies Processed=12,209; Copies Marked=9,386; Copies Unmarked=0: Copies Missing=2,826
- Pohnpei campus LRC is satisfied to announce the accomplishment of cataloging new books from H&D products. Books are now ready to be used by anyone.
- Conducted the Spring 2016 library survey to students and faculty on May 2-3. There were 62 students or 38% of the student population, who participated in the survey. The library services was given a general average weighted mean of 4.24 or Excellent, in a scale of 5. Five full time faculty participated in the survey, indicating VERY SATISFIED in the level of satisfaction to the library resources and services. Requested Townsend Press for the examination copy/Instructor's copy of

the book, *The Advanced Reading-Writing Connection* by John Langan –book was received and forwarded to Jovita for evaluation and review.
