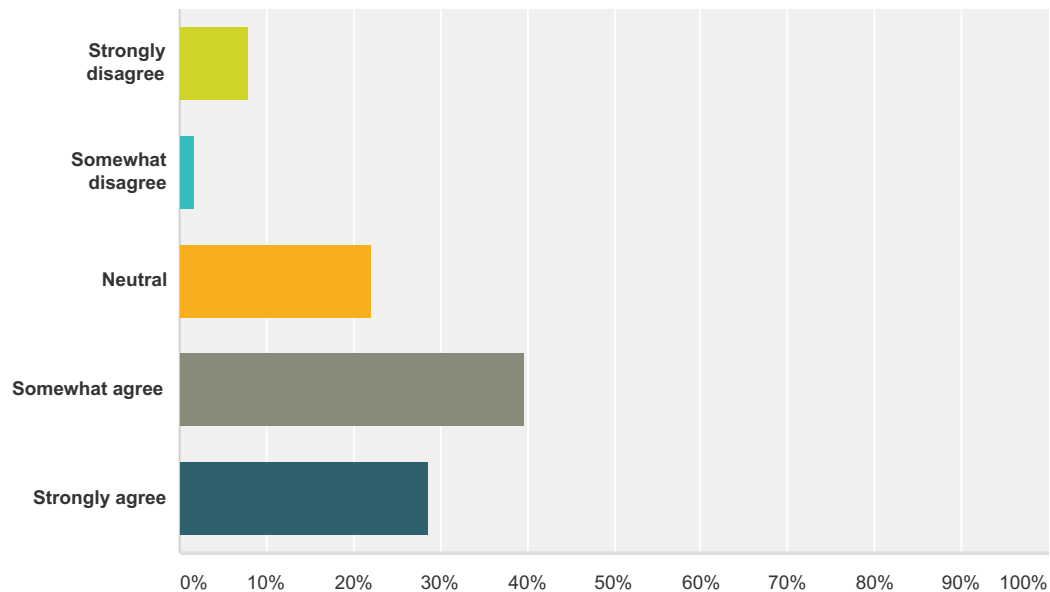

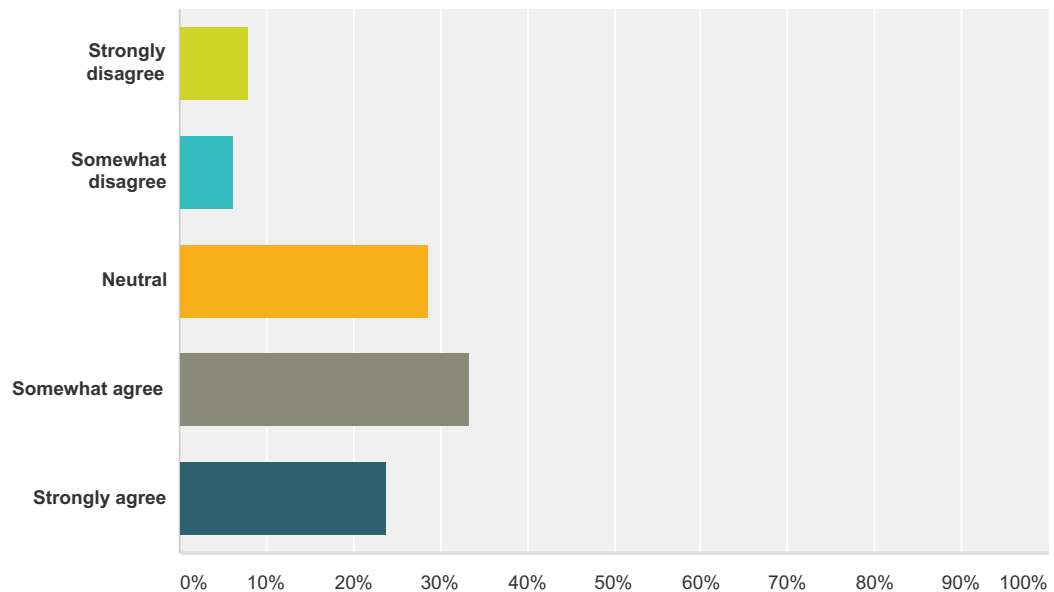

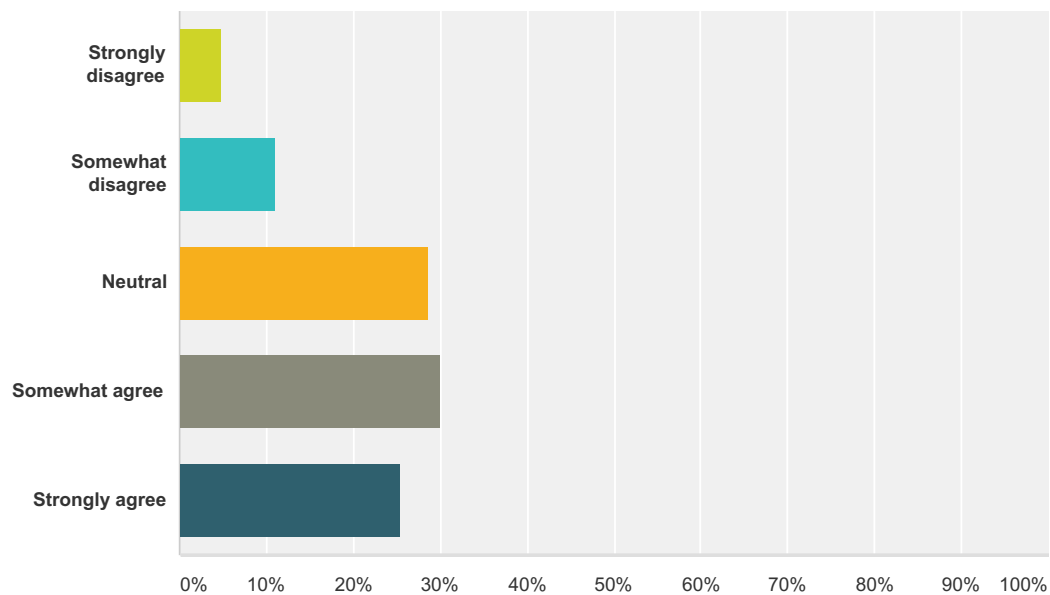

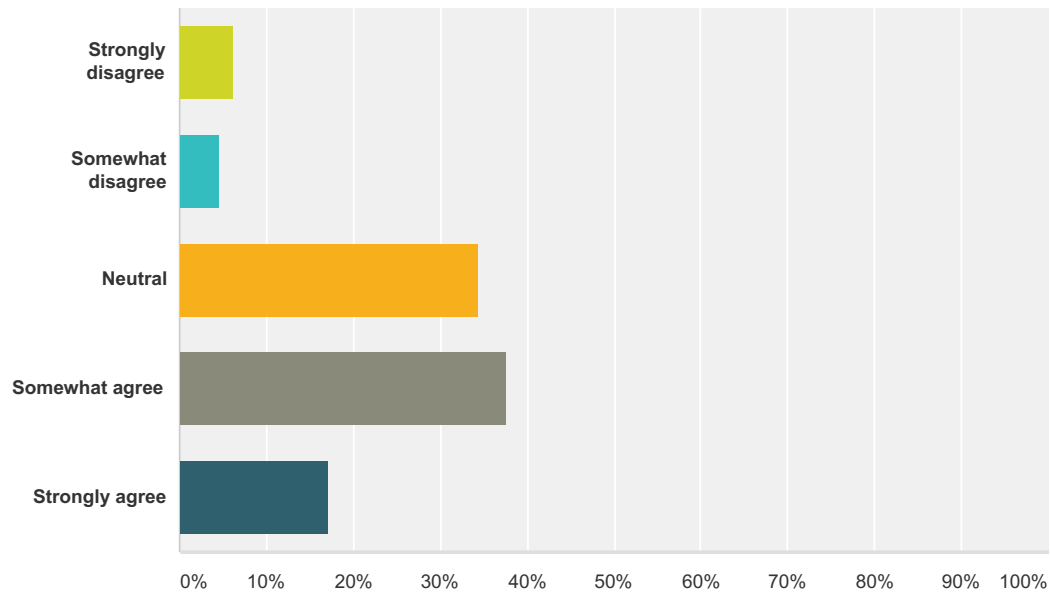

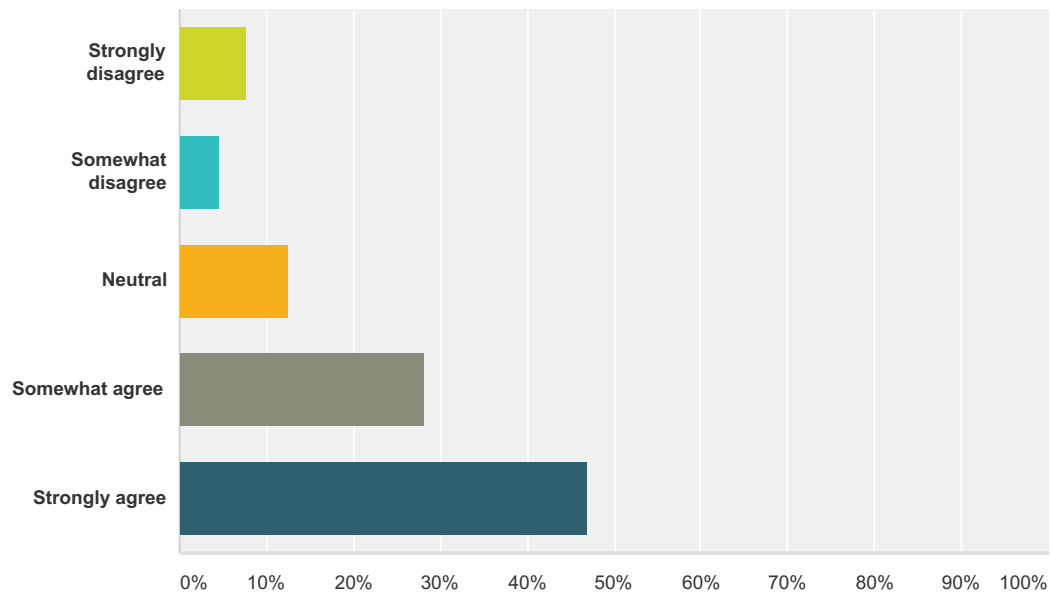

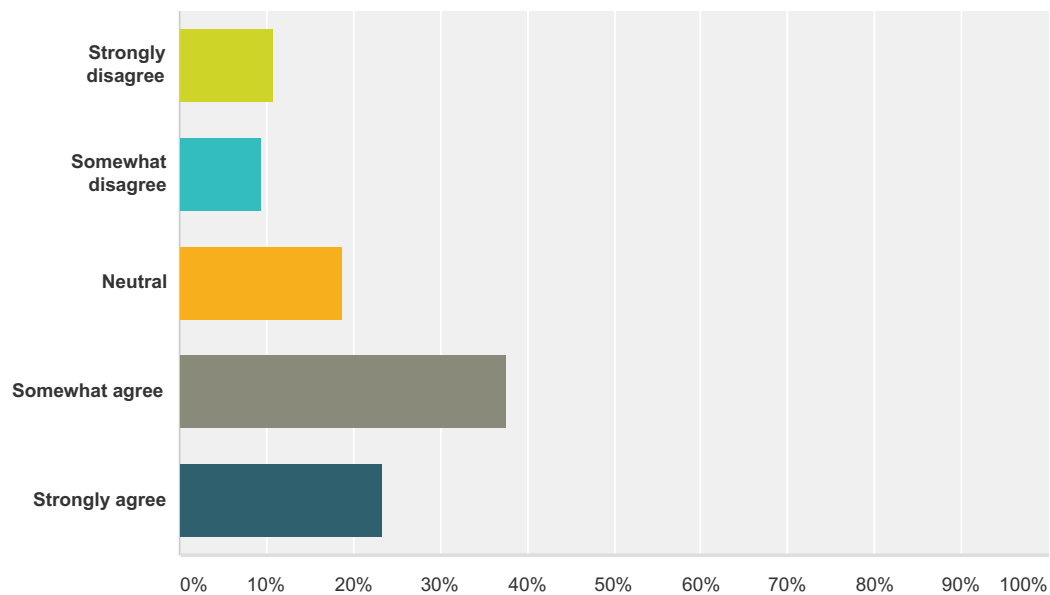

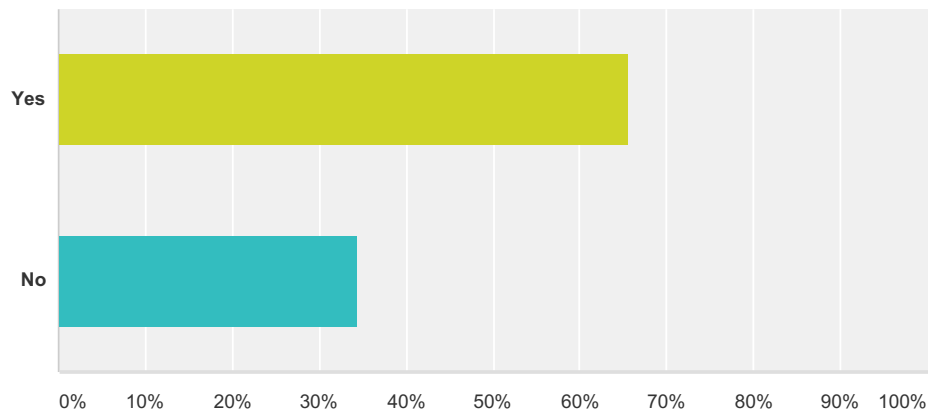

### Q40 Do you feel confident that you will not be sexually mistreated by students at your institution?

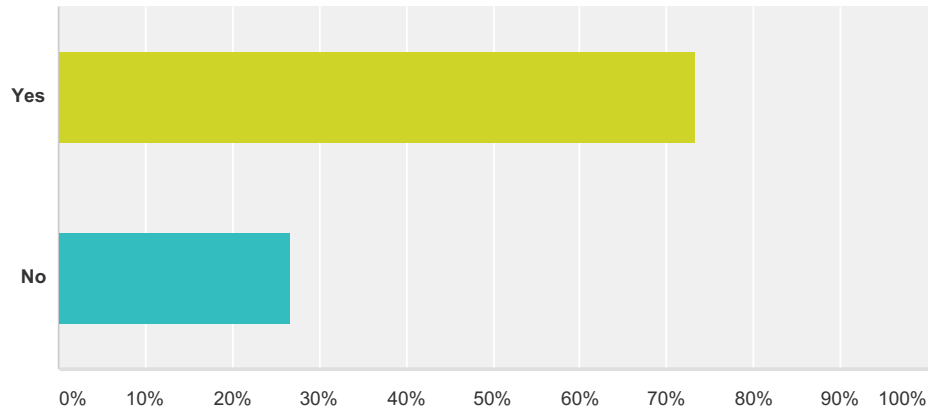

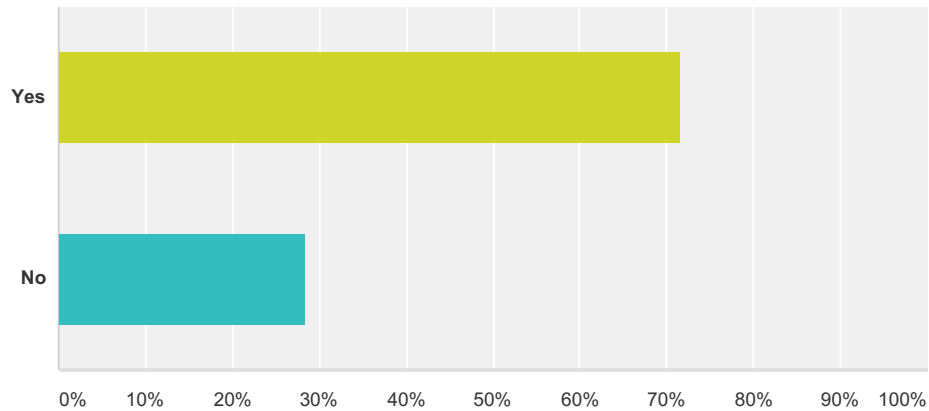

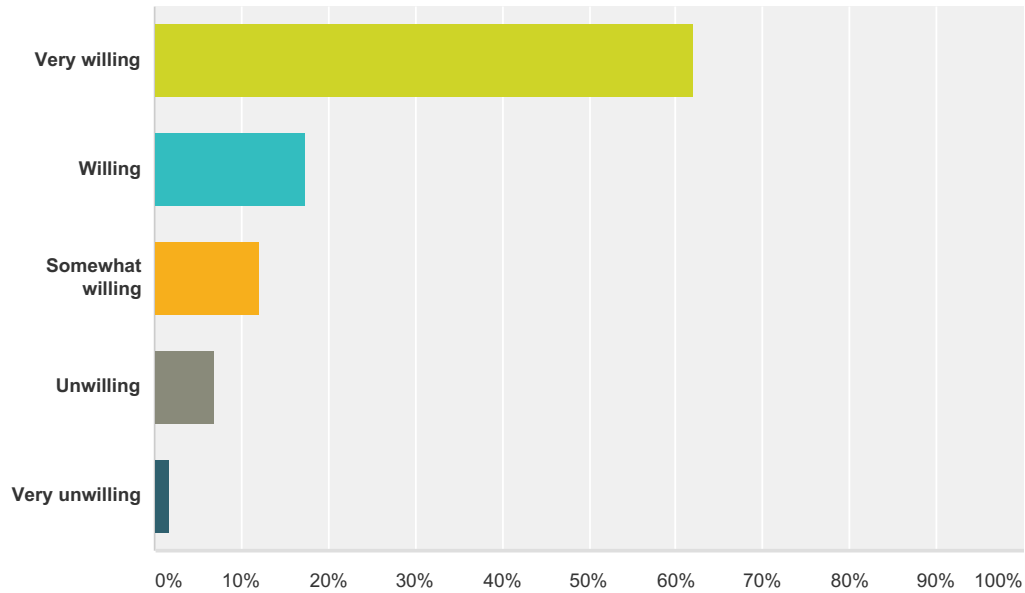

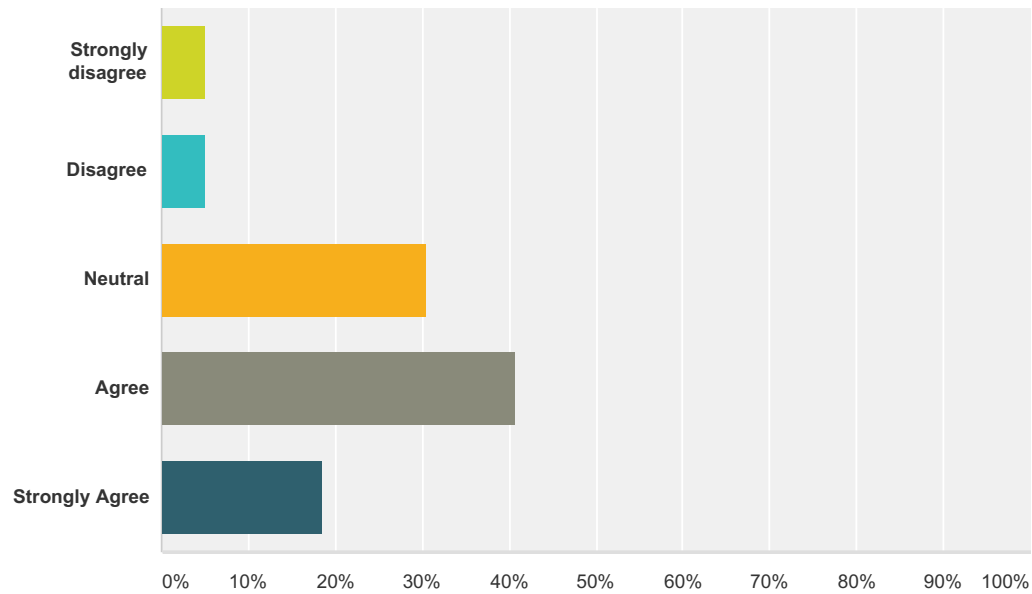

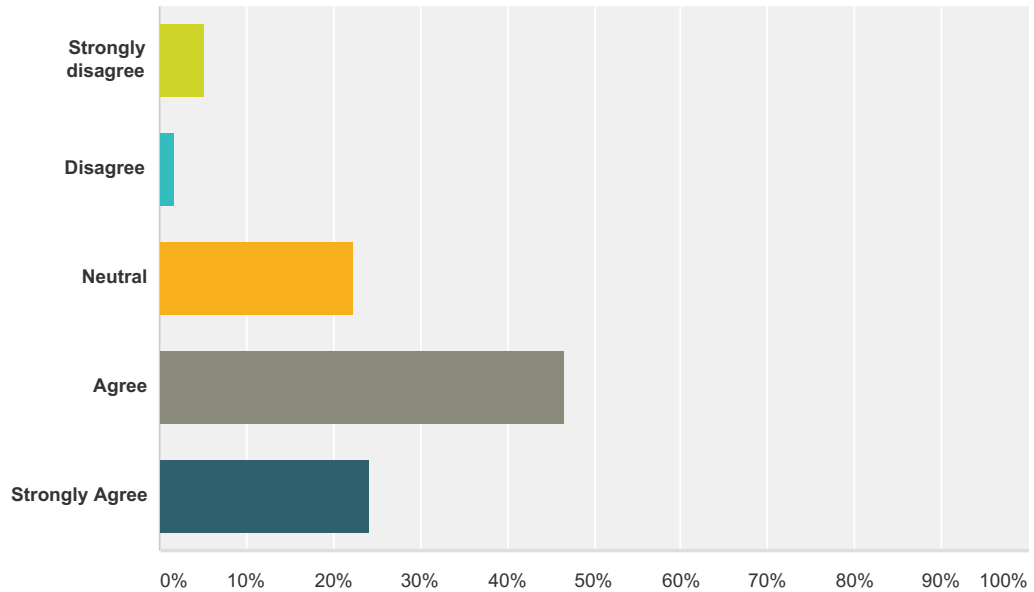

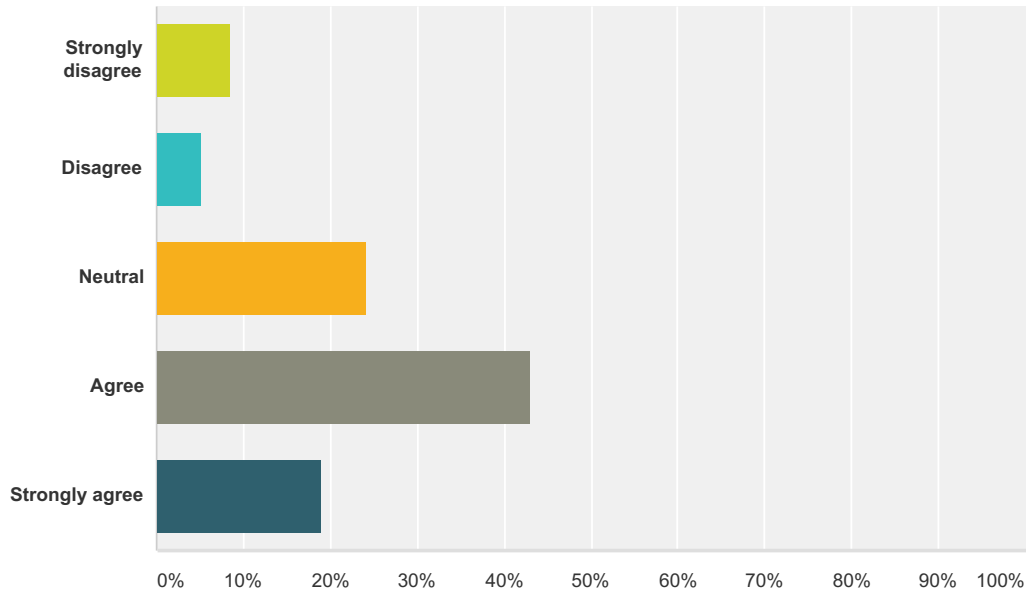

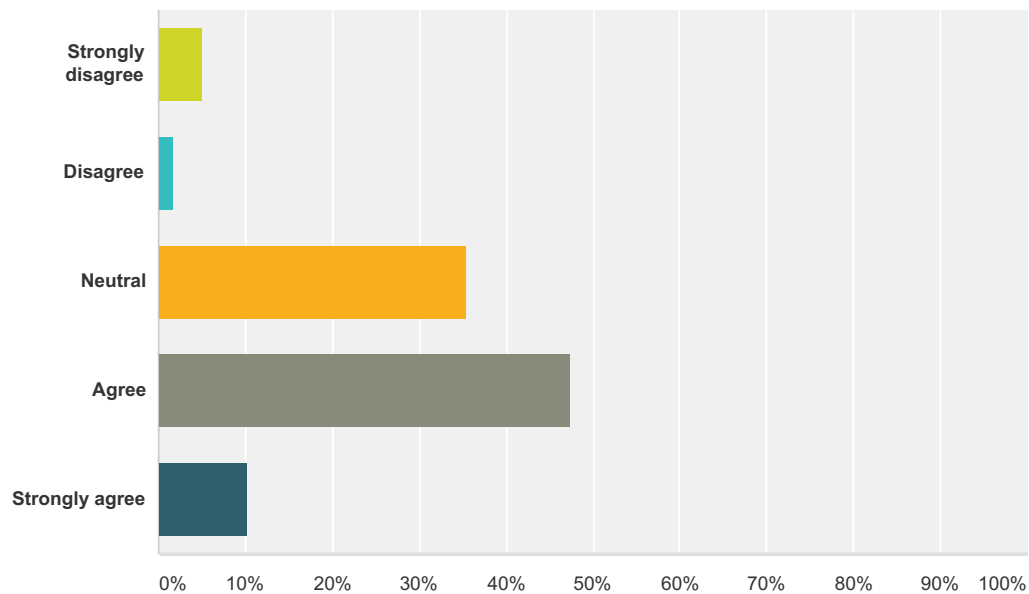

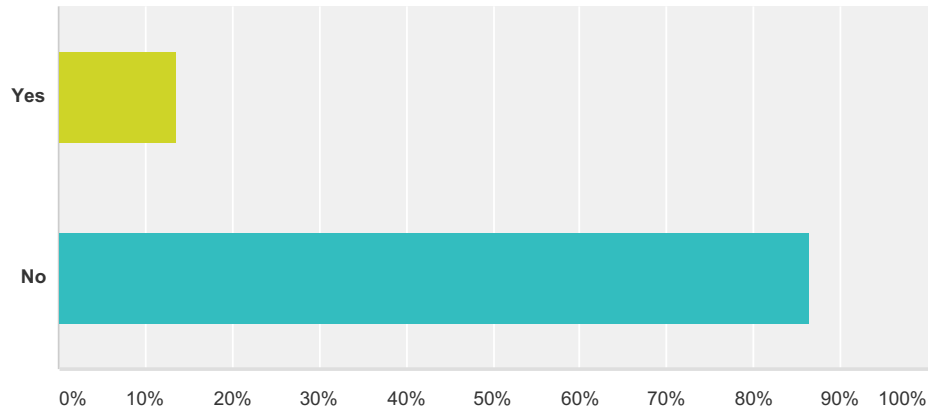

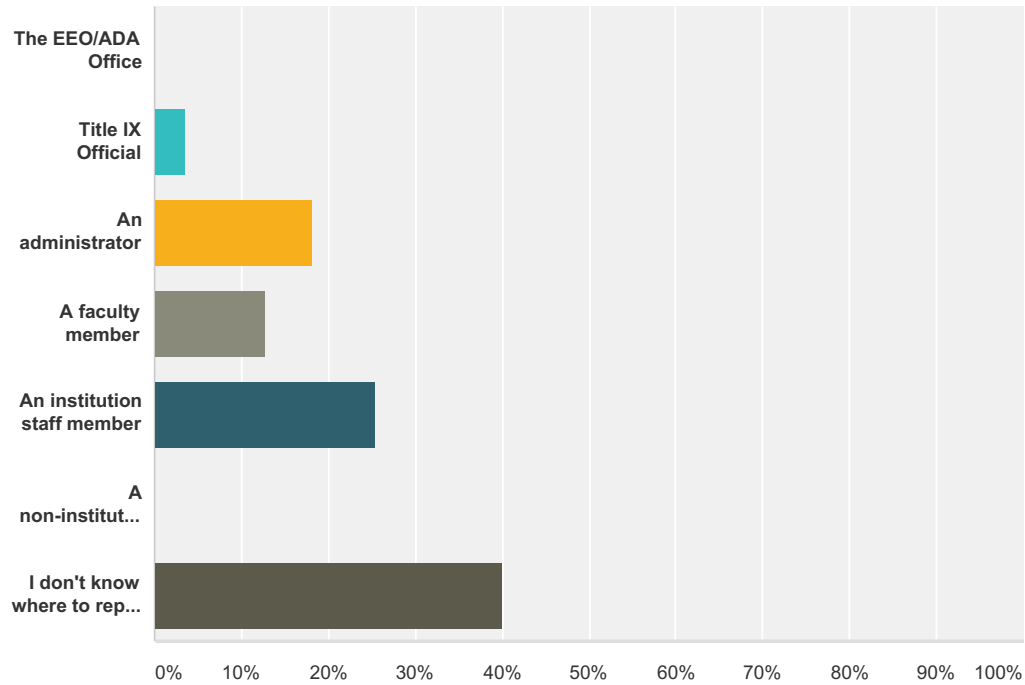

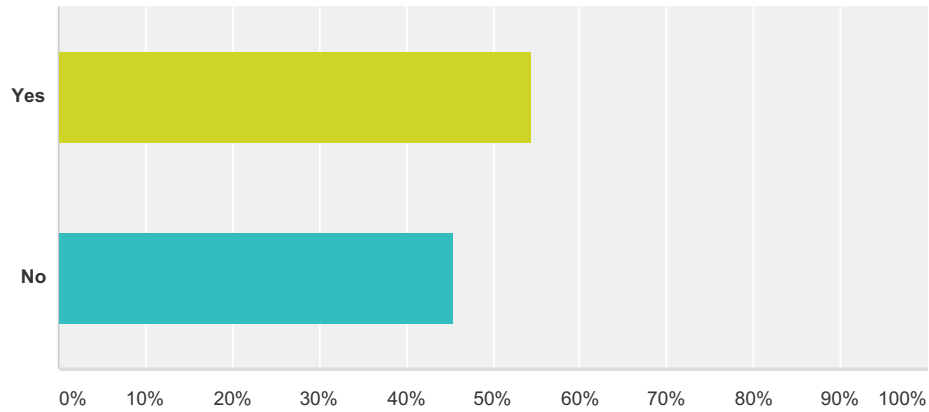
