Subj: Curriculum Committee Meeting Updates for August and September 2017

The Curriculum Committee has had three meetings since the beginning of the Fall 2017 semester (Aug. 21, Sept. 4 and Sept. 18) and so this memo serves as our first communication to the Office of the VPIA with a summary of updates on what has transpired in these CC meetings:

- 1. TOR Discussions led to a reduction in CC members to include: 6 instructional coordinators, 2 faculty reps for each campus (10), 1 library rep. and the ex-officio. Former division chairs as well as campus reps who were on the committee have withdrawn from the committee and have sought out alternative committees to serve on. The updated TORs have been posted on the wiki by the CC Vice Chairperson.
- 2. A schedule for the full 2017 Academic Year has been approved and has been posted on the college calendar and arrangements made to reserve the BOR conference room for all of our meetings. The schedule is as follows:

- **4.** Sylvia Henry withdrew from her post as a member of the CC as well as the CC secretary so that she could devote her time fully to the Faculty/Staff senate of which she is president. Deeleeann Daniel was elected as the new CC secretary.
- 5. Course Outlines Review: The CC Vice-chair will now be responsible for posting approved minutes and documents to the wiki as well as following up with committee work such as course outline review with members of the CC. Additionally, the ICs will be responsible for following up on course outlines that were reviewed and returned to authors/programs so that they can be revised with suggestions from reader teams and returned to the CC in a timely manner. Hopefully, with this procedure in place, the review of course outlines can be expedited. All new members will be forwarded their assigned Course outlines to review.
