 - ACE English II from 55% to 58%
 - ACE Math I from 66% to 70%

- Provide training for ACE instructors on best practices for developmental education at least one time each semester.
- Assess changes in course outlines for improved student learning
- Work with student services to ensure that tutors are available from the first day of instruction and to hire tutors specifically for ACE.
- Continue to advocate for raising entrance criteria for ACE courses
- Hire a full-time coordinator for ACE to ensure success of the program.
