1a. Means of Program Assessment & Criteria for Success:

Students attend Library Orientation

Criteria for success: At least 3 orientations scheduled per Fall/Spring semester and 1 during Summer semester.

1a. Summary of Assessment Data Collected:

From the Spring 2008 semester:

- 4 orientation sessions held with an average of 15 students per session.
- Approximately 60 students attended library orientation

From the Summer 2008 semester:

- 1 orientation session was held to approximately 14 students.

From the Fall 2008 semester:

- 15 orientation sessions were held.
- Approximately 175 students attended library orientation.

1a. Use of Results to Improve Instructional Program:

We are meeting the criteria for success. We are making a strong effort in this area.

Number of library books checked out by students.

Criteria for success: 200 books per month or more.

2a. Summary of Assessment Data Collected:

From the Spring semester 08 class:
280 books per month average were being checked out.

From the Summer semester 08 class:
180 books per month average were being checked out.

From the Fall 2008 semester:
302 books per month average are being checked out.

Meeting criteria. New books being purchased every month. Use of library strongly encouraged by all Faculty.

Student library usage.

Criteria for success: At least 100 students per day use the library.

From the Spring semester 08 class:
101 students per day average used the library.

From the Summer semester 08 class:
86 students per day average used the library.

From the Fall 2008 semester:
158 students per day average used the library.
