DAIKIN R-32 AIR CONDITIONING TRAINING IN FSM

Through the effort of the Office of Environment and Emergency Management (OEEM) to provide training for the countries refrigeration technicians, DAIKIN AIR CONDITIONING conducted demonstration training on R-32 for split air conditioners to promote the used of ozone friendly and low global warming refrigerant in the FSM. All the members of the Pohnpei RAC technician association, including the college RAC program instructor, AC technicians and apprentices from Pohnpei and National campus, attended the training. Also the RAC technician's association president from Chuuk, Kosrae, and Yap are present in the training.

Since the FSM government is phasing out the used of R-22 in the country, the OEEM is also looking for other replacement other than R-410a, which is commonly used in our new air conditioning system nowadays. According to the Daikin experts, R-32 is a non ozone depleting substance (ODS), low global warming potential (GWP) and an energy efficient refrigerant for new split type air conditioning unit . It is labeled as a slightly flammable refrigerant by the American Society of Heating Refrigeration Air conditioning Engineers (ASHRAE).
