## REPORT

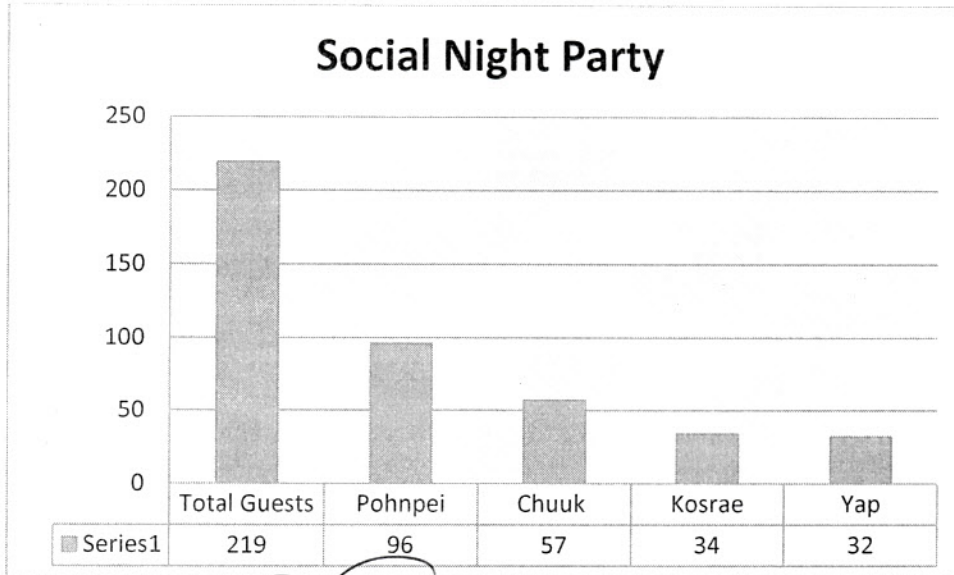
The type of assessment used for the social night party was survey questionnaires. The expected number of guests was 300 in the proposals. During the night, we had 219 participants. Out of the 219 participants, the number of people that did the survey is exactly 200.

- ❖ Out of the 200:
  - 64% learned something from the activity and thought the environment was appropriate.
  - 92% agreed that we should protect sharks
  - 100% thought the performances were up to pleasing
  - 98% absolutely agree that the activity promoted social awareness and civic mindedness.
  - Most of the students that came a little later than 6pm, complained that there were not enough food, but that was just because they were late.
