Outreach Awareness Program:

A workshop that will bring the Kapingamarangi and the Nukuoro community's awareness, of the College of Micronesia, FSM especially with these areas:

This workshop's target was to make sure that both the parents and the students are well aware of how the COM-FSM operates and what are expected of the students when they are in the college. This workshop was held in the Pohnrakiet Nahs (hale Daane) on the 30th of October at 6:00 to 8:00 pm. The weather was rainy but in spite of the weather, most of the parents in the village and from the Nukuoro community showed up for this workshop and have quite a lot of concerns and questions for the people who represented the divisions from the college.

Before the workshop even begins, the NuKap distributed Pre Tests to all the people who showed up that night including the high school students and elementary students. The Pre - Tests were collected back and most of them were not answered for they claimed that they do not know while some claimed that especially for the sport part, that it is a waste of the students' time. As the workshop continues on, the islanders asked questions as soon as a presenter is done on his or her part which was the main reason why we, the officers of NuKap wanted to have the workshop in our community. There were times where the islanders just speak their heritage language as they ask questions and the NuKap COM- advisor Bollie translate the question to the COM-FSM representatives during the workshop. At the end of the workshop, the NuKap students passed a Post-Tests to all the people who showed up that night. As expected, they finally learn to answer all the questions based on what they learned that night during the workshop. The workshop was consisted of 253 people altogether with the elementary students, high school students members of the society and parents.

The community leaders were there along with the Nukap community advisors which include: Kapingamarangi senator Edgar Lickaneth, Nukuoro senator Cindy Lekka, Chief of Kapingamarangi: Andrew Lucky, President of KYC: Nickson Dickepa along with the Nukap Advisor Bollie L Taulung.
