



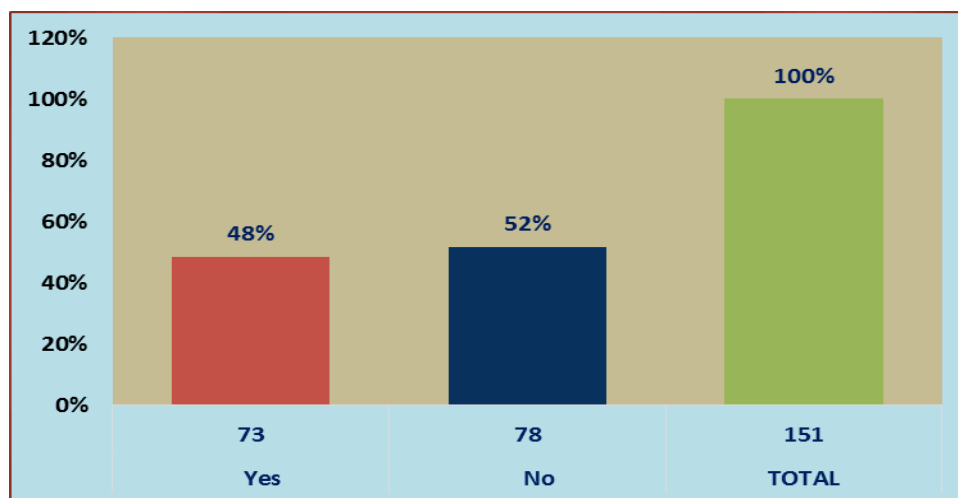

LIBRARY INSTRUCTION SURVEY RESULT

Fall 2014

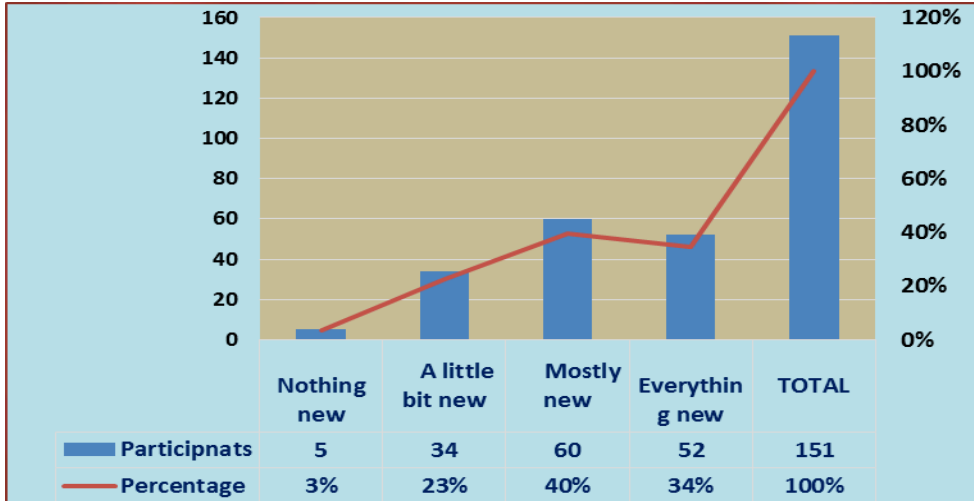
This fall 2014, the survey conducted for eight (11) classes of EN120A-Expository Writing 2 (two classes), EN120B -Expository Writing 2 (four classes), ED486- Building teaching strategies (one class), PH316- Public Health (one class), SS200- Research Methods (two class) and SS280- Directed Study (one class). These class sessions had conducted just before a mid-term paper has been assign. Most of the presentation discussed the Modules 2 & 3 (OPAC, E-Journal & BIBME). In the survey students are asked to fill out a six (7) questions on the content of the presentation and open-ended questions to know what they found useful about the session, their suggestions to what they what to learn more and comments on the Instruction. One hundred twenty two (151) students participated in this semester survey.

Survey Result



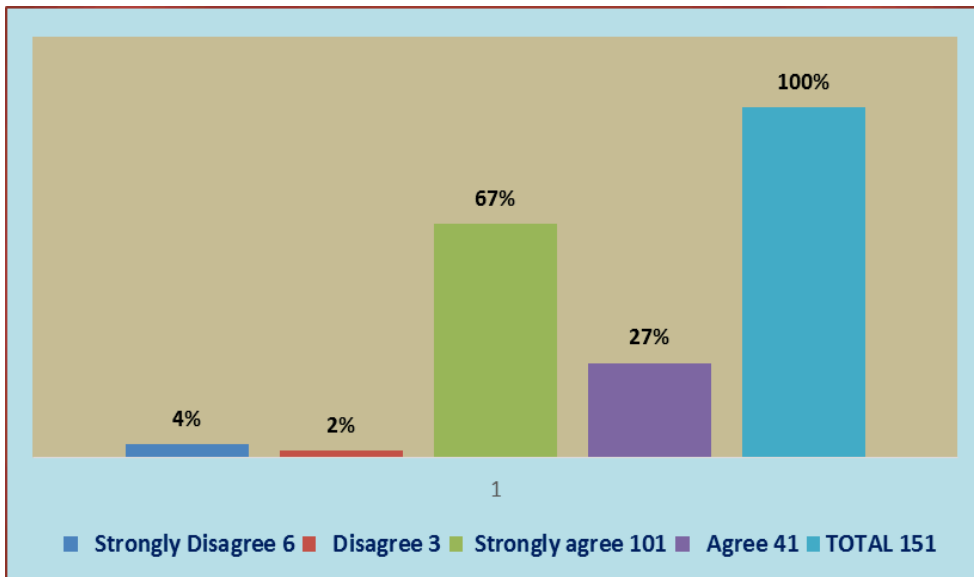
Graph 1: Percentage Rate of the Library Instruction experienced

Graph 1 shows that most of the students participated in this survey experienced library session before. More than half of the participants, which are 78 or 52%, reported that it is not their first time to attend the session, while only 73 or 48% responded reported that it is their first library instruction experience.



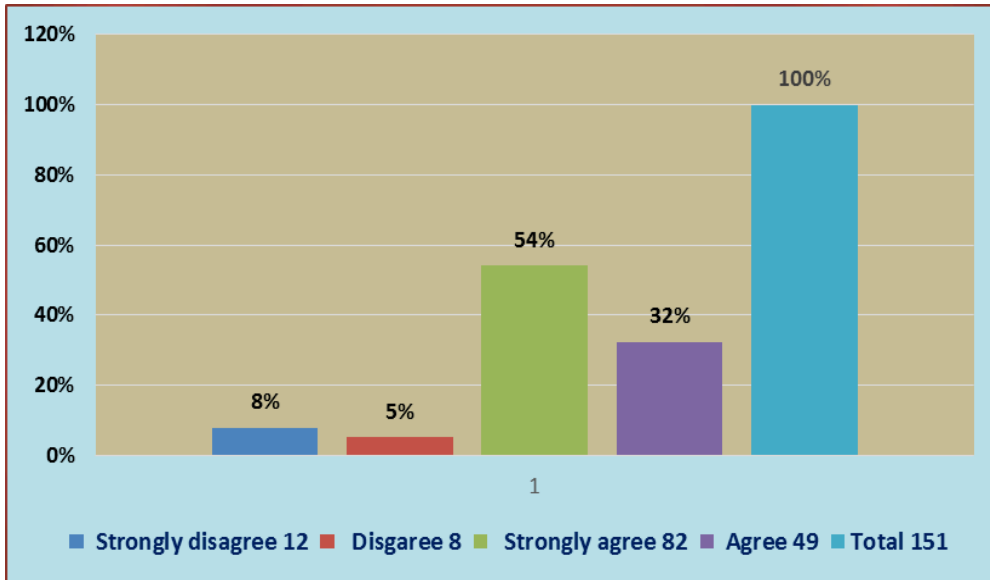
Graph 2: Survey Rate on How much of the information taught in this session was new to them

The graph 2 indicated that 60 or 40 % responded that the information taught are “Mostly new” to them and 52 or 34% responded “Everything new”. It shows that only 34 or 23 % responded “a little bit new” and for “Nothing new” only 5 or 3% responded.



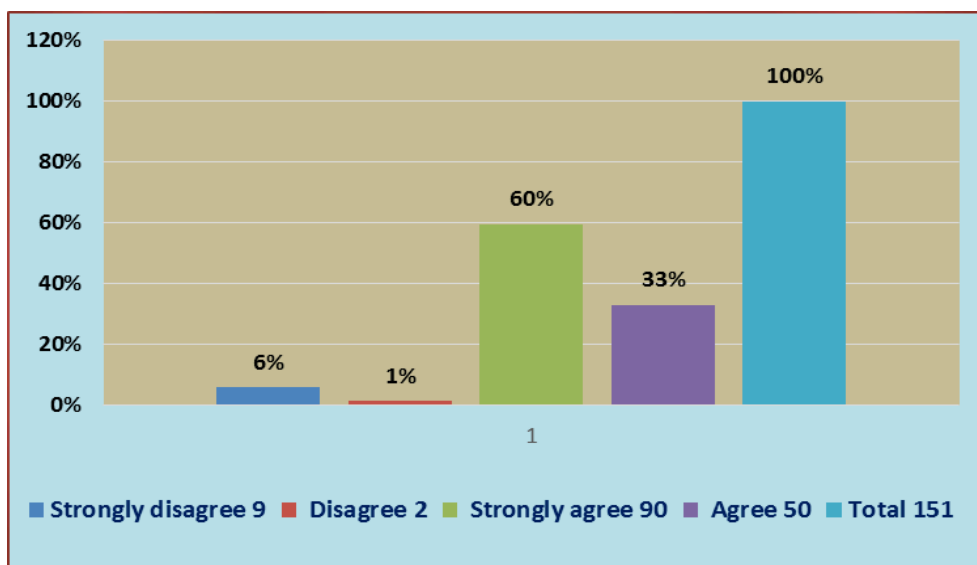
Graph 3: Result on the understanding of the information gathering and research process after the Library instruction

The graph 3 revealed that majority (101 or 67%) of the participants are “Strongly agreed” that they understand the information gathering and research process after the session while 41 or 27% are “Agree.” Only 6 or 4% responded “Strongly disagree and 3 or 2% “Disagree.”



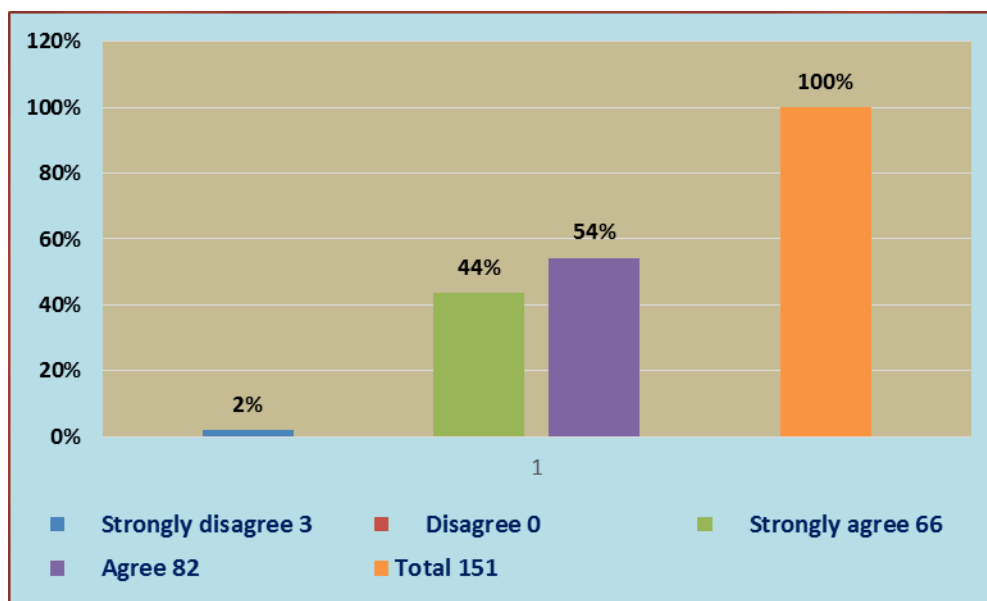
Graph 4: Survey Rate on the Relevance of Library Instruction for their information needs

Graph 4 shows that more than half (82 or 54%) of the respondents “Strongly agree” that the library instruction was relevant to the information that they need while 49 or 32% “Agree.” Only 12 or 8% “Strongly disagree” and 8 or 5% “Disagree” on the relevancy of the information taught in the instruction.



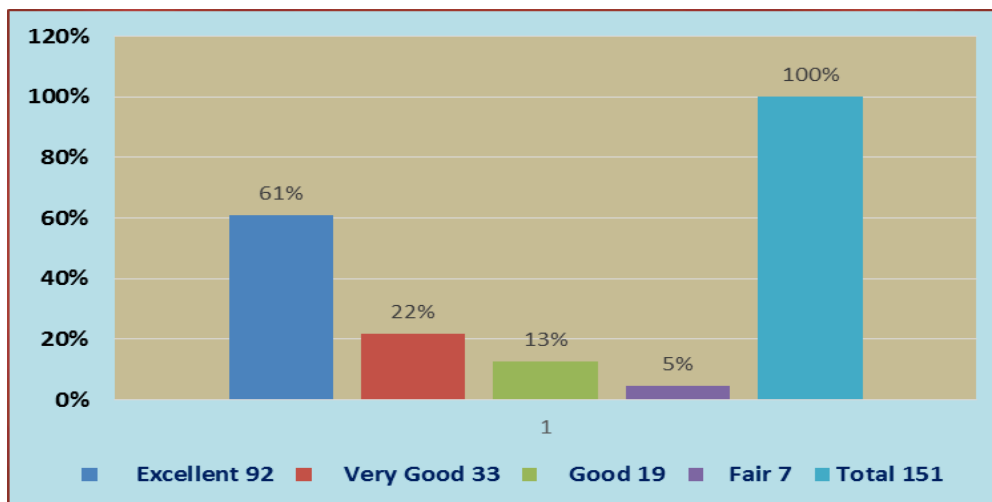
Graph 5: Percentage Rate of Library instruction in terms of useful knowledge

In graph 5, majority of the participants (90 or 60%) “Strongly Agree” that instruction is useful knowledge that they can use after the session and less than half (50 or 33%) responded, “Agree.” Only 9 or 6% responded “Strongly disagree” and 2 or 1% “Disagree.”



Graph 6: Percentage Rate if better prepared for work in other classes after the session

From the data shows in graph 6, 82 or 54% “Agree” and 66 or 44% “Strongly agree” that after the session, they are better prepared for work in other classes. Only 3 or 2 % of the participants responded, “Strong disagree”



Graph 7: Survey Rate on the Overall Evaluation of the Library Instruction

For graph 7, revealed that majority (92 or 61%) of the participants rated “Excellent”, 33 or 22% responded “Very good” and 19 or 13% “Good” while 7 or 5% responded “Fair” for the overall quality of the library session

In table 2, 94 or 62% of the respondents participated in this item. They suggested what they want to learn more in other library session. Most of the suggested topics that the respondents want to learn more are the following: more on citations, more research tools, BibMe, and research strategies.

Result Summary

- Most of the student this semester attended the library instruction before.
- Students' participated in this survey reported that session taught **mostly new** and only 3% reported that nothing new.
- Majority of the students participated **strongly agreed** that they understand the information gathering and research process

- More than half of the participants ***strongly agreed*** that the library instruction was relevant to the information that they need.
- Participants' also ***strongly agreed*** instruction is useful knowledge that they can use in other class work.
- More than half of the participants ***strongly agreed*** that after the session they are better prepared for other class work.
- The overall rating for library instruction is "Excellent"
