



The college tried its' best to ensure that students' first year experience will enable students' success.




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













Q090. In advising new students, to what degree do you: Help them select courses



Q091. In advising new students, to what degree do you: Discuss what it takes for them to be academically successful





Q095. Use of Assessment - To what degree has the following information directly influenced your work with new students: Measures of pre-enrollment academic skills from this institution's databases




